A word from Pastor Paul Royappa

Beloved in Christ,

Greetings to you all in the most powerful name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.

I am indeed grateful to God for bringing me and my family back once again to IMC to continue to serve God and His people. As you all know this is my third term here at IMC. God's plans and ways are higher than our plans and ways. As I look back and see, how God has been guiding and sustaining me for the past 31 years in the ministry, I am humbled and my heart is filled with gratitude and thanksgiving.

Ministry Journey of Rev. Paul K. Royappa



Rev. Paul K. Royappa comes from a ministry background. His father Late Rev. Royappa served God as a CSI Presbyter for more than 4 decades in Madurai-Ramnad Diocese, Tamil Nadu. Mother Late Mrs. Mary Royappa was a school teacher. Both his father and mother were prayer warriors and had a passion for Missions and Evangelism. He has 3 brothers and a sister. And 2 of his elder brothers are in full-time ministry.

Rev. Paul Royappa surrendered his life to God and had a salvation experience when he was in 10th standard in 1982 and received a call from God for the ministry when he was finishing his B.Sc. at American College, Madurai in 1988.

Pastor Royappa has been in the ministry for 31 years. He served as the Director of Youth for Christ Ministry in Tamil Nadu for 10 years from 1990 to 2000. He pursued his Master of Divinity at Trinity Theological College, Singapore from 2000 to 2003. Upon completing his theological studies, he came back to India and joined the Methodist Church in India in 2003.

Pastor Royappa started his Pastoral ministry journey as the Pastor of Calvary Methodist Church, Mysore from 2003 to 2008. Served as the Assistant Pastor of Indiranagar Methodist Church, Bangalore from 2008 to 2012, Served as the Pastor of Panjim Methodist Church, Goa from 2012 to 2014. Served as the Associate Pastor of Richmond Town Methodist Church, Bangalore from 2014 to May 2017. Served as the Associate Pastor of Indiranagar Methodist Church from June 2017 to November 2017. He served as the Lead Pastor of the Protestant church in Oman (PCO)- Salalah on loan from the Bangalore Regional Conference from December 2017 to April 2021.

He came back from Oman to Bangalore with his family to continue to serve God with the Methodist Church on April 24, 2021. He is married to Rachel who helps him in the ministry and they are blessed with a son Allan, a gifted musician who finished his Master's at Monash University, Australia a few months back and he is currently in Bangalore teaching Music.





IMC VBS REPORT 2021

IMC VBS 2021 was held online via Zoom between 19th May to 29th May and the theme was "The Kingdom of God" which was based on Luke 12:32. All of us in the VBS Team experienced the reality of the statement, 'The Lord equips those He calls,' as finally we had 226 children that registered, and we had to find more teachers to join us even after VBS had started.

The VBS sessions were held in two batches. The Beginners, Primary & Junior classes were held in the morning between 10:30am to 12:00pm, while the Inters, Seniors & College class met in the afternoon between 3:30pm to 5:00pm. The children would watch the General Session video that included a VBS Spotlight video, a time of praise and worship, and the Daily Theme was introduced at the beginning of the session. This was followed by the lesson, memory verse and activities for the day.

We had VBS Daily colour code or Dress Codes based on the lesson that was being taught that day. It was wonderful to see the children and teachers dressed up in the specified colours and themes. We also had a VBS Bible Character/VBS Talent Day that was held of 26th of May, where the Beginner & Primary classes got dressed as Biblical Characters and the rest of the classes showcased their talents, all for the glory of God. This served as a reminder for all of us at VBS, of the Lord's numerous blessings in the lives of the children & the teachers as well.


The VBS Closing Service was held on 30th May 2021, via Zoom between 4pm – 5pm. The Pastoral Team prayed for the entire VBS family, along with the opening prayer, closing prayer and benediction. Short video clippings of all the children in their 10 days of VBS classes and the VBS Team were played as a part the VBS Spotlight videos. The VBS Candid videos captured the children at their homes as they attended VBS, and the VBS Teachers and Volunteers. We also heard a few VBS testimonials from children, parents and teachers.

In-spite of the challenges of the current second wave, we praise God for His enabling and equipping us all to serve Him. At VBS we witnessed the devastation of Covid in various forms, we had teachers who were recently recovering from Covid, or had family members and loved ones hospitalized due to Covid. We also had VBS team members lose family members just before VBS started & during VBS. We had VBS children that had lost a parent or a loved one to Covid just a few days before VBS had started. The Lord in His mercy enabled us all to minister to the children in the midst of this anxiety, pain and deep loss. We are grateful that the Lord caused us all to persevere, and has used VBS for His glory alone. We are amazed at the Lord's doing and it is marvellous in our eyes! All Glory be to God alone.


