



Pastoral Letter



Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Loving greetings to you all in the precious name of our Lord Jesus Christ.

The Bible says in Deuteronomy 31:8, 'The LORD himself goes before you and will be with you; he will never leave you nor forsake you'. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged." Let our hearts overflow with gratitude to the Lord who has safely and wonderfully brought us to the last month of this year 2021. Yes, there is a growing concern about a new variant of Coronavirus. We are to be cautious. Our God is sovereign and in control. Let us continue to look to our Almighty God for protection and favour. Let us not fear the future because of the current situation. Instead, let us move ahead confidently focusing our full attention on God, who has promised never to leave us.

We the Pastoral team thank and praise God for all of you for your prayers and constant support. We too assure you all of our prayers. Thank and praise God for the ministry of our Sunday school, MYF, WSCS, MMF, Poor Fund and other committees every month. A special word of thanks to our Worship teams, Choir and Audio/Visual team for their dedicated ministry every Sunday.

Last month we focused on 'CULTIVATING A LIFE OF THANKSGIVING'. We have entered into the most exciting and long awaited month of the year - the Christmas month. It is easy to get caught up in the preparations and festivities during this season that we forget the real meaning of Christmas. The theme for this month is 'THE CHRIST OF CHRISTMAS'.

We have a saying, "Jesus is the reason for the Christmas season." That's partly true; "We too are the reason for the season". Jesus came for you and me. We read in John 3:16, "For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life". He came, because His love for us compelled him to come. Christmas means that God sent his only Son Jesus so that we could believe in him and have eternal life. Christmas is nothing but Jesus. And if Jesus is not in Christmas, then Christmas is nothing at all!"

The miracle of Christmas is that God chose to come to be with us in Jesus Christ. The Christmas message is often lost in the secular world of consumerism, commercialism and materialism. The message of Christmas is simple yet profound. The Gospel tells us about the Christmas message.

First, the message of Christmas is a message of 'Fear not': This message came to Mary when she was told in Luke 1:30, 'Fear not, for you have found favor with God.' In Luke 2:10, the angel said to the Shepherds, "Do not be afraid. I bring you good news that will cause great joy for all the people". Over the last 2 years, due to COVID-19 pandemic, fear has become chronic and burdensome. Though our lives are slowly getting back to normal, we are still living in fear and we celebrate Christmas amidst unusual concerns due to COVID-19. Those who lost their dear ones or their jobs this year may have a very quiet Christmas surrounded by many concerns. Christmas for Joseph and Mary was a time of concern. When Joseph was afraid, the angel said to him in Matthew 1:20, Joseph son of David, "Do not be afraid to take Mary home as your wife, because what is conceived in her is from the Holy Spirit." God who cared, comforted and counselled Joseph is ready to do the same to us if we too are overwhelmed by many concerns of life.

No matter what fear we are facing right now, let us make a commitment to seek Christ first and trust in His Power and deliverance. DO NOT BE AFRAID...The same Words of hope that God gave to Joseph, Mary and Shepherds is giving you no matter what your fear is. Never forget the message of Christmas, '**FEAR NOT'**.

Secondly, the message of Christmas is a message of Peace. We read in **Luke 2:13-14**, Suddenly a great company of the heavenly host appeared with the angel praising God and saying, "Glory to God in the highest heaven and on earth **Peace** to those on whom his favour rests". Peace is not a state of mind. It is a condition of the heart. It is a fruit of the Spirit. A gift from God. Real Peace consists not in the absence of trouble but in the presence of God. We read in Eph 2:14 that '**Jesus is our peace**'. He is not only our peace, He is our '**Prince of Peace'.** Our peace with God comes as a result of Jesus dying on the cross for our sins. The moment we confess and repent of our sins and ask God for forgiveness, we have peace with God. Do we have peace with God? If not, it is time to confess our sins to God and repent.

The Bible says in **Philippians 4:6-7**-"Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving present your requests to God, and the **peace of God**, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus." This is the peace that God gives when we face dark times, when life is hard and when we go through a storm in life. Christ alone can give this peace. Are you anxious about anything? Pray with thanksgiving in every situation. You will experience the peace of God.

Romans 12:18 - 'If it is possible, as far as it depends on you, live at peace with everyone'. **Heb 12:14-** 'Make every effort to live in peace with everyone and to be holy; without holiness no one will see the Lord'.

Many relational problems in families and outside would be quickly

resolved if we would follow Paul's simple guidelines. Go to the other person in a spirit of gentleness and humility, seeking to restore the relationship. Our goal in any relational conflict is not to win or to put the other person in his/her place. Our goal is to honour Christ by growing in maturity and humility. Are we sharing God's peace with one another in our family, workplace and the church? Jesus said in **Matthew 5:9 -** *Blessed are the peacemakers, for they will be called the children of God*. The way we treat one another reflects our relationship with God. We can always work toward peace and reconciliation. Peace is a wonderful fruit that God wants us to possess. It is a fruit that the Holy Spirit grows in us as we allow Christ, our Prince of Peace to rule our lives. As we celebrate Christmas, let us make sure that we have peace with God, peace of God in us and peace with others through JESUS CHRIST.


