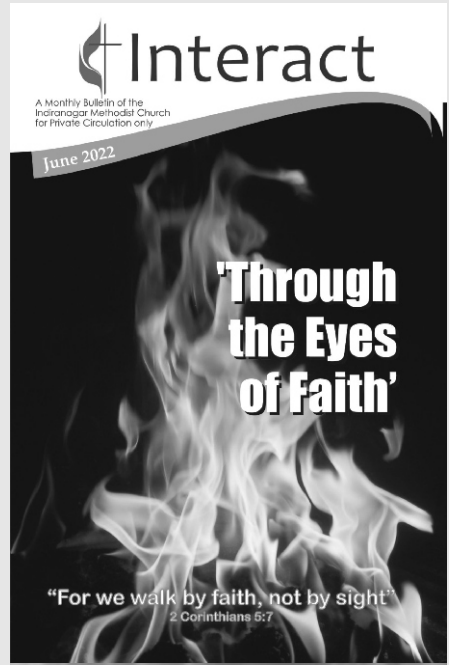

Pastoral Letter

Dearly Beloved IMC members,

Greetings in Christ's precious name.

We praise God for the new month of June and thank God for the previous month of May 2022. The Lord has been good and gracious in blessing us in the past month.

We praise and thank God for the overwhelming response for our Church **VBS** from April 27 to May 8 and **Vernacular VBS** on May 13 & 14. Many Children committed their lives to Christ. We thank the VBS Director, Teachers, Volunteers. Also thank you all for your prayers and generous contribution for the VBS. Thank God for the **MMF** (Methodist Men's Fellowship) retreat we had in Goa from May 20-22, 2022.

As we have entered the month of June 2022, we will be focusing on faith. Faith is a prominent phrase & according to the bible it is essential to Christianity. Without demonstrating faith & trust in God, we have no place with Him. Most people have a vague, disjointed notion of who God is but lack the reverence necessary for His exalted position in their lives. True faith goes beyond a simple acknowledgment of God's existence (Jam 2:19) to a life-changing reliance on who God is, as revealed in the Bible. Faith can falter at times, but, because it is the gift of God, given to His children, He provides times of trial & testing in order to prove that our faith is real & to sharpen & strengthen it. This is why James tells us to consider it "pure joy" when we fall into trials, because the testing of our faith produces perseverance & matures us, providing the evidence that our faith is real (Jam 1:24). Hebrews 11:1 tells us that faith is "being sure of what we hope for & certain of what we do not see." Perhaps no other component of the Christian life is more important than faith. We cannot purchase it, sell it or give it to our friends.

So what is faith & what role does faith play in the Christian life? The dictionary defines *faith* as “belief in, devotion to, or trust in somebody or something, especially without logical proof.” It also defines *faith* as “belief in & devotion to God.” The Bible has much more to say about faith & how important it is. In fact, it is so important that, without faith, we have no place with God & it is impossible to please Him (Heb 11:6). According to the Bible, faith is belief in the one, true God without actually seeing Him. Faith is not something we conjure up on our own, nor is it something we are born with, nor is faith a result of diligence in study or pursuit of the spiritual. (Eph 2:8-9) makes it clear that faith is a gift from God, not because we deserve it, have earned it, or are worthy to have it. It is not from ourselves; it is from God. It is not obtained by our power or our free will.

Faith is simply given to us by God, along with His grace & mercy, according to His holy plan & purpose, & because of that, He gets all the glory. The bible is very clear in recording the examples of faith in Hebrews 11 known as the faith chapter. So as we journey through the month of June, as a church, we will meditate in our pulpit study the theme '**Through the Eyes of Faith**'. At the same, let's uphold all the people who are in need of prayers for health issues, & also pray for our church children, who will start their academic classes from this month of June 2022.

Let's continue to pray for the outreach ministry at the **Electronic City (The Methodist Worship Center)** for the families who are regularly attending the church service in the evening. We value your continued prayers and support for our Church planting and outreach ministry. Please uphold the Pastoral team and their families, also the Pastoral ministry in your personal prayers every day.

In closing, we the Pastoral team, pray that God would be with all of us as we journey through the month of June & help all of us live a life of faith & be blessed by our Lord Jesus Christ. Amen.

Day 1: 13 May, Friday Teacher Orientation and Preliminary session for the children. Ms Grace brought the word of God and briefed the teachers about the VBS lessons. Teachers had a meaningful time of prayer. Around 150 children participated in the preliminary session. Rev Paul Royappa started the session with prayer, followed by soulful singing and worship by our own Sunday School students and sharing by the VBS team. This session was to prepare the children and to bring other kids for day 2.

Day 2: 14 May, Saturday The day started with teacher's devotion and general session for the children. More than 350 children ranging from 3 years to 18 years attended with great enthusiasm. The worship team, led the children in a time of singing. In the general session, Ms Grace brought out the theme from the life of Gideon. Bible lesson on Gideon was taught in classes. Colourful craft work was done to help them learn the memory verse easily. We ministered to the parents who accompanied the children too.

A sumptuous lunch was arranged for all. A small gift was given to each of them. Copies of New-testament were made available and given to those who wanted it.

We witnessed God's presence and mighty hand through these two days. We thank the Pastors, Pastorate Committee and the people who prayed, participated and supported financially. Let the Word sown in their hearts, grow and bear fruit!!

The Pencil Story

A girl was watching her grandmother write a letter. At one point she asked “Are you writing a story about what we've done? Is it a story about me?” Her grandmother stopped writing her letter and said to her granddaughter”. I am writing about you actually but more important than the words is the pencil I'm using. I hope you will be like this pencil when you grow up. Intrigued the girl looked at the pencil. It didn't seem very special. “But it's just like any other pencil I've ever seen”. That depends on how you look at things. It has five qualities which if you manage to hang on to them, they will make you a person who is always at peace with the world.

First quality: You are capable of great things, but you must never forget that there is a hand guiding your steps. IMC VBS Report - 2022

April 27 - May 8

The Lord has been merciful and gracious indeed! After having online VBS's for the past 2 years due to the pandemic, we were finally able to have VBS offline this year! We are grateful for the Lord's protection over the VBS Team and all the children and their families and extended families as well. Our theme at VBS this year was "Holding on to God", based on the theme verse, Heb 10:23. It is the prayer of the VBS Team that each child would continue to truly focus on Holding on to Jesus in their journey and learn to Let go of the things that hold us back from fully experiencing Christ.

At VBS this year we had over 150 student registrations and a VBS TEAM that comprised of over 85 Teachers and Volunteers. VBS spanned over 12 days and had 8 lesson days. 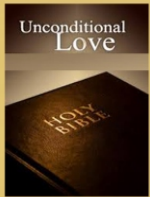

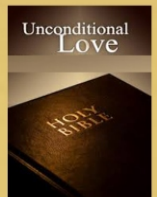
