Thomas Ken 1637-1711



he word doxology comes from two Greek words, *doxa*, which means glory, and *logos*, which means word. So a doxology is literally "a word of glory." We sing doxologies to give glory or praise to God. In countless languages this "Doxology" is treasured. Yet few know the story behind these words, first published in 1709, and fewer still the life of their composer, Anglican **Bishop Thomas Ken (16371711)**. *Praise God from whom all blessings flow;.......*These words were written in 1674 by Thomas Ken as the final verse of two hymns, "Awake, my soul, and with the sun" and "Glory to thee, my God, this night," intended for morning and evening worship at Winchester College.

Bishop Thomas Ken was born in Berkhamsted, England in July of 1637. His father Thomas was an attorney in the Court of Common Pleas and his mother's name was Martha. Martha died when Thomas was only four years old. In 1652 Thomas entered Winchester College, where he was an exemplary student. In 1656 he entered Oxford and was ordained in 1662. After a decade of several pastorates, he returned to Winchester College to serve in various capacities, including chaplain to the bishop. He also composed poems, prayers and hymns, some of which would later be published in a book entitled "Manual of Prayers".

Towards the end of his life, Thomas Ken was imprisoned by King James II, for his forward Protestant thinking. Upon his release, he quietly retired from the priesthood and went to live with some friends until his death on March 11, 1711. At Ken's request, the hymn was sung at his funeral, fittingly held at sunrise.
