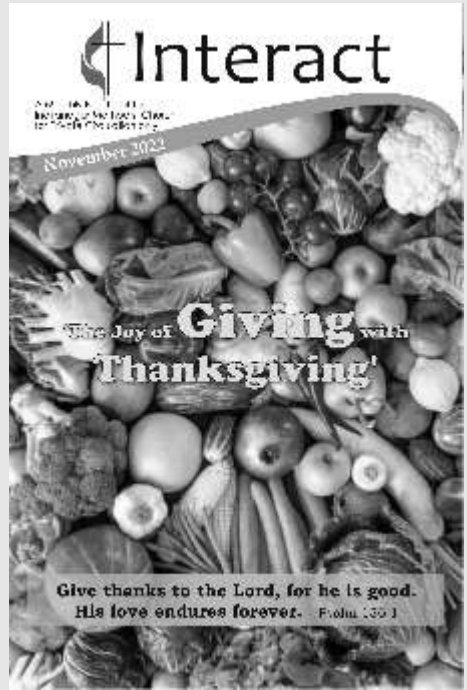

In Everything Give thanks

A king who did not believe in the goodness of God, had a slave who, in all circumstances, said: My king, do not be discouraged, because everything God does is perfect, no mistakes!

One day they went hunting and along the way a wild animal attacked the king. His slave managed to kill the animal, but could not prevent his majesty losing a finger. Furious and without showing his gratitude for being saved, the nobleman said "Is God good? If He was good, I would not have been attacked and lost my finger."

The slave replied: "My king, despite all these things, I can only tell you that God is good, and he knows "why" of all these things. What God does is perfect. He is never wrong!"

Outraged by the response, the king ordered the arrest of his slave. Later, he left for another hunt and was captured by savages who made human sacrifices. In the altar, ready to sacrifice the king, the savages found that the victim had not one of his fingers, so he was released. According to them, it was not so complete to be offered to the gods.

Upon his return to the palace, he authorized the release of his slave that he received very affectionately and said - "My dear, God was really good to me! I was almost killed by the wild men, but for lack of a single finger, I was let go! But I have a question: if God is so good, why did he allow me to put you in jail?" The slave replied - "My King, if I had gone with you in this hunt, I would have been sacrificed for you, because I have no missing finger, therefore, remember everything God does is perfect. He is never wrong."

Often we complain about life, and negative things that happen to us, forgetting that nothing is random and that everything has a purpose. Every morning, offer your day to God, don't be in a rush.

Ask God to inspire your thoughts, guide your actions, and ease your feelings. And do not be afraid. God is never wrong! Trust His plans. His plans are higher than our plans. Believe in Romans 8:28.

QUESTION AND ANSWER: HOW CAN I CONTROL MY ANGER?

We read in James 1:19-20 that everyone must be quick to hear, slow to speak and slow to anger; for the anger of man does not achieve the righteousness of God. St. Paul says in Ephesians 4:26 'In your anger do not sin'. There is a kind of anger which the Bible approves, often called "righteous indignation (Mark 3:5; John 2:13-18)." But Anger turns to sin when it is selfishly motivated (James 1:20), when God's goal is distorted (1 Corinthians 10:31), or when anger is allowed to linger (Ephesians 4:26-27).

Anger can shatter communication and tear apart relationships, and it ruins both the joy and health of many. Sadly, people tend to justify their anger instead of accepting responsibility for it. Everyone struggles, to varying degrees with anger. The point I want to emphasize is that we need to be wise, because if we are angry and miserable we gain nothing. It is like a bad habit we need to get out of it. We may not succeed with our first, second or third effort but, if we persistently try to overcome our anger, eventually we will be successful. When controlling anger, the important thing is not to suppress it, but deal with it positively.

It is always about the past. It is about what someone did or said or about something that happened. Anger is one of the biggest causes of stress and depression. If you are failing in this area of controlling your anger, I would like to give some practical suggestions which I have found them very useful.

1. Guard your tongue: If we speak in anger we will definitely aggravate the situation and likely to hurt the feelings of others. You need to calm yourself down, and let the feeling of anger subside. If we can remain outwardly silent it gives time for the emotion of anger to leave us." When angry count to ten before

you speak. If very angry, count to one hundred. "- Thomas Jefferson. Don't do anything or make any decision when you are angry. Depend on the Holy Spirit to guard your tongue. Self-Control is the fruit of the Holy Spirit.

2. Be wise and alert to overcome anger: Whenever you encounter anger, you need to take a step back and say to yourself "This anger will not help me in any way. This anger will make the situation worse." We must remember the importance of keeping the volume of our voices low (Proverbs 15:1).

3. Keep Peace and joy a priority: If we value peace of mind as our most important treasure, we will not allow anger to remain in our system.

4. Prayer and meditation on God's Word: Practice meditation on the Bible regularly. Use the Word of God at the time of testing. We must always act to solve the problem (Romans 12:17-18). We cannot control how others act or respond, but we can make the changes that need to be made on our part. Overcoming a temper is not accomplished overnight. But through prayer, meditation on the Bible and reliance upon God's Holy Spirit. Next time when you get angry, apply these methods, you will experience peace and joy. Ask God. He will help you and you will be victorious and joyful.

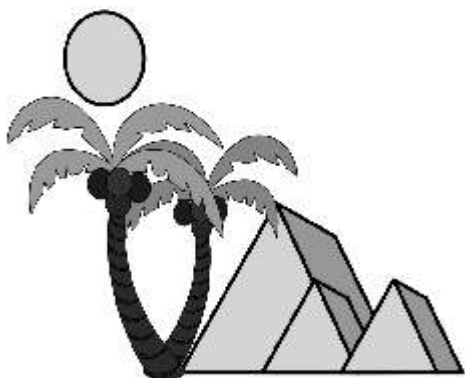
