

Pastoral Letter

Dear IMC members,

Greetings to you in Christ's Precious name.

Jesus said in Mark 5:36, '*Don't be afraid; just keep trusting'*. In the Bible, the story of Israel's conquest over Jericho is a peculiar one. God instructed men and priests to march around the city, blow trumpets and end with a loud battle cry. This may seem little strange to read in the beginning, but latter we understand how God brought down the mighty wall and gave Jericho in the hands of Israelites. If the Israelites had not followed the whole plan of God, they would have failed to conquer Jericho. Similarly, when we fail to trust God and His plan, we fail to see the miracles of God in our lives.

Fanny Crosby (1820-1915) is heralded as one of the world's most prolific and talented hymn composers. Blind from shortly after birth, Fanny nonetheless wrote 8,000 hymns. One day Fanny overheard her friend and fellow musician Phoebe Knapp playing a new composition on the organ. Phoebe told Fanny the tune was called *Assurance*. Fanny replied: 'Blessed Assurance! Jesus is mine!' And so began the collaboration that was to become one of Christendom's most beloved hymns. *Blessed Assurance* was published in 1873.
