

Pastoral Letter

Dear beloved IMC members,

Greetings in Christ's precious name.

We thank our gracious God for being so good & merciful to each one of us. As the month of February got over & March has begun, we all look forward to learn new things from new opportunities with God's help. Last month, the Lord has spoken to each one of us regarding Godly virtues. As we continue the Lenten season, we will focus on 'Walking in the Footsteps of Jesus' this month. When we read the bible, in each instance, God was looking for those who were willing to set aside their personal comforts and interests to follow him and share in his ministry. He wanted obedient, focused, and committed followers who would not only trust him but would submit to his authority and way of doing things, even when it wasn't comfortable or easy. The choice, however, was theirs. Abraham believed in God, and the Bible says, "it was credited to him as righteousness" (Gen 12:6). Jonah, on the other hand, ran from God's call to Nineveh, fearful of what might come of such a risky venture (Jonah 1).

Jesus warned his would-be disciples that following him wasn't for the faint of heart. "If anyone wishes to come after Me," he said, "he must deny himself, and take up his cross and follow Me. For whoever wishes to save his life will lose it; but whoever loses his life for My sake will find it" (Matt 16:24-25). Authentic discipleship must be motivated by a deep, personal relationship with our Savior. As we begin to model our walk after the example of Christ, we will begin to see true heart-change in the people around us. What does it really mean to trace the footsteps of Jesus and walk the same path He walked? ave you given up anything for Lent? Perhaps you have decided to follow a new diet or turned off social media. Lent is a reminder of the time that Jesus spent in the desert being tempted before entering into ministry. By giving up certain foods for example, we start to understand what it might have been like for Jesus to be tempted by Satan to turn stones into bread. The practice of Lent is to

encourage us to echo the life of our Saviour who suffered for us, who gave up all riches and power that we might be free and saved from the bondage of sin.

Think of yourselves the way Christ Jesus thought of himself. He had equal status with God but didn't think so much of himself that he had to cling to the advantages of that status no matter what. Not at all. When the time came, he set aside the privileges of deity and took on the status of a slave, became *human*! Having become human, he stayed human. It was an incredibly humbling process. He didn't claim special privileges. Instead, he lived a selfless, obedient life and then died a selfless, obedient death and the worst kind of death 'Crucifixion'.


