

# Pastoral Letter

#### Dear IMC Family,

Greetings to you all in the matchless name of our Lord and saviour Jesus Christ.

Praise be to our God who was with us throughout the past nine months of this year and has brought us to this new month. Let us be encouraged that He will lead us every moment of our life till the very end. Thank God that we observed **Poor and Needy Sunday** on Sep 8<sup>th</sup> and **Senior Citizens' Sunday** on Sep 29<sup>th</sup>. Also thank God that our young people had a blessed **Youth Camp** at Yelagiri from Sep 14<sup>th</sup> to 16<sup>th</sup>.

This month, we the pastoral team have prayerfully chosen the theme "Marks of a spiritually thriving church". No one wants to stay as a baby. We all grow up. It is interesting to see our children grow up and observe the various stages of maturity. It is rewarding to see others growing and learning new things.

Just as there is mental and physical growth there is spiritual growth. We don't want to remain babies in our spiritual understanding but we are to grow in grace and in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ. We want to grow in spiritual understanding and get to know God better. As doctors suggest that muscles never develop unless they are brought to the maximum point. Similarly, it is the same with spirituality. To grow spiritually

also we must exercise our spiritual muscles. We need to exercise our faith and trust God to do the impossible. Let us look at how the early church grew spiritually.

Acts 2:42-47 give us a number of insights from the early church in Jerusalem. How it really grew in spirituality. The early church had ten characteristics. They were a learning church, a church of fellowship, a church that was an obedient, a praying church, a reverent church, they expected things to happen, they shared their goods, they worshipped together, they were a joyful church and they were a winsome church. As we examine these areas think about two things. Where do you as an individual need to grow and where do we as a body of Christ need to put some of those into action. When we speak of a church, we never mean just a building but we speak of the body.

First, the early church continued in fellowship together. Fellowship is not just eating or talking together. Fellowship is being concerned about each other like a family. As Christians we are the family of God and we need to be helping each other with encouragement and support whenever we can. In the early church this was not just emotional or spiritual, it extended to those who were poor and needed financial help. We need to be

sensitive to those less fortunate than us around the world. The family of God is not just this little group. It extends around the world.

Second, the early church was a learning church. They studied the Word of God diligently. But it was not just a head knowledge, they diligently obeyed the teaching of the apostles. Perhaps we should read the Bible more and watch TV less. We should be more diligent to understand and obey the Bible. We are very fortunate to have the Word of God preserved and translated into our own languages so that we can understand and obey. Not only they did study the Word but they prayed together. When Peter was in prison the church gathered and prayed. An angel came and released Peter from the jail. Prayer is the need of the hour. Praying people are the only people who have influence with God, the only kind of people to whom God commits Himself and His Gospel. Praying people are the only people in whom the Holy Spirit dwells, for the Holy Spirit and prayer go hand-in-hand. Let us continue to pray for each other, the ministry of our church, our upcoming Missions Sunday and Thanksgiving service, our outreach ministries in Electronic City and Marasandra for the needs that are both spiritual and financial.

Third, the early church went daily to the sanctuary. There they would praise God and listen to His word. They were a happy and rejoicing people. The early church grew because the apostles were able to maintain proper priority in their ministry. What is our number one priority when we come to IMC? Is it worship God in spirit and truth and grow spiritually?

Fourth, they were a mission minded people. Let us also be witnessing church let us also be a mission minded people. In Acts 2:47 it says that every day the Lord added to the church those being saved. I get thrilled thinking that this is a possibility. Every day someone coming to know Christ as their redeemer. People losing all fear of death and committing their lives to love and obey God. People being free from the bondage of death and hell.

So, what are the marks of a growing vibrant church? First, they fellowshipped together Second, they were a learning church. They were a praying church which brought miracles. They were a witnessing church, as a result there was a revival and thousands of people were added daily. Since they were faithful to God, God added to the church people who were being saved. Thank God for the vision and mission, He has given to IMC to be His Light and Salt in this world. May God continue to help us to grow as the early church grew spiritually and physically. Amen.



The Great Malabar Doctor: Biography of Kerala's first Medical Missionary

# Eugen Liebendorfe,

was a German missionary associated with Basel Missions in India. He is known to have brought a real breakthrough for medical missions in the Indian mission field. By birth, he was a Christian but began living as a true Christian ever after he attended a spiritual revival meeting in the German Luther Church in the early 1870s. He then joined the Basel Mission, which assigned him to serve in Southern India.

At the age of 23, he arrived at Calicut on 1 October 1875 and then began working in Tellicherry's mission station. Although not a professional, his basic knowledge of medical treatment helped him to develop relations with the locals and preach the Gospel.

He also began writing articles on human anatomy in Malayalam



to make the Indian doctors more knowledgeable. But a turning point in Eugene's ministry came in 1882.

On 7th July 1882, Eugen witnessed the deaths of 60 people due to the collapse of a bridge. Though how much he tried, he managed to save only 20 people. He was deeply affected by that incident and felt that he could have saved more people if he had sufficient medical skills. Hence, he returned to Germany in 1883

and spent time in medical training.

While many thought that he fled the mission station, Eugene returned to Calicut, now as a full-trained missionary doctor in 1886. Soon he was able to establish a small hospital and thousands began visiting him. People referred to him as the 'wonderful German doctor' and the 'great Malabar doctor.' But, Eugene never let the fame get to his head. He always told people that Iesus is the master healer and he was just Jesus's assistant. He personally prayed for every patient before he treated them. There were many instances when the patient would get relief from pain just by prayer even before the treatment began.

Eugene also founded 'Association for Medical Mission' in 1898 to expand medical missions. The hospitals he built at Calicut are still intact and one serves as a dormitory for girls. A second mission hospital was also built at Bettageri, Coorg as part of the Basel medical mission. Eugen Liebendörfer had chronic health issues and died at the age of 50 years in Stuttgart, Germany on 3 October 1902.
